- (vii) Utmost care should be given to ensure that name and identity of the Board of Examiners are not disclosed as it is strictly confidential to facilitate free & fair conduct of examination.
- (viii) Translation is required to be carried out wherever needed. Each set of question paper, either in English or bilingual (English and Hindi) is to be mailed in pdf/word format.
- (ix) For UGCF-NEP, a total of 8 questions should be given in a paper of 90 marks and 3 hrs (3 lectures) out of which students will have to attempt 6 questions. 


