



The Department of Biomedical Science had organized an event "Aliferous Beginnings" on 7th March 2022,1:30p.m. Aliferous Beginnings is a series of talks given by the alumni of Department of Biomedical Science of Shaheed Rajguru College of Applied Sciences for Women, University of Delhi, to help the students make an informed decision regarding their careers.

The guest of honour for the event was Dr. Parul Tomar, an Alumni of Chimera Department, batch of 2007-2010.

Dr.Parul is currently working as a Commercial Manager- Research Solutions at Merck Life Sciences Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai. Through her talk, she shared her journey of shifting from Academics to Industry.

She gave entrance examinations for Masters in TIFR, NCBS, IIT-JAM and ACBR. She stood AIR-01 in ACBR and AIR -02 in IIT-JAM. She did her Masters (2010-2013) in TIFR, Mumbai in Quantitative Genetics. In 1st year, she had been assigned to a lab with 6 month coursework. Her 2nd year and 3rd year was fully oriented on research ,thesis defense and publication in the Research Journal. Through her Master's at TIFR, she got a mini -exposure to the research world and to building a scientific network. Then she completed her PhD in Maxplank Institute, Germany (2013-17) in Functional Genomics/Epigenetics .

As of now, being a part time business person, she shared how the Biomedical students can enter in an industry and have various opportunities in several post such as in Research and Development, Sales team, Technical Sales team, Marketing team, Business Development and Customer service

Introduction of the event was done by the meeting hosts-Simra Khan (3rd year), Nisha Singh (2nd year) and Vishakha Soni (1st year). The event was preceded by a few words of wisdom by our HOD, Dr Shruti Banswal. Next, our guest speaker, **Dr. Chaitali Khan**, was introduced. Dr Khan gave a brief introduction on her life's trajectory and her research work on the fundamentals of cancer biology. She used Drosophila as a model system. 

HIV-TB CO-INFECTION MODEL WITH MDR STRAIN





OBJECTIVES

This work aims to develop a model to study the effect of HIV-TB coinfection in a person. The following are some of the objectives we want to achieve through this work

- Study the various equilibrium points of the model.
- Calculate the Basic Reproduction Number and study its variations with respect to various parameters.
- Study the effect of force of infection on the trajectory of the disease.
- Predict the trajectory of the disease on the basis of the concentration of cells.

INTRODUCTION

People living with HIV are more likely to become sick with TB as compared to others . According to WHO, the risk of developing TB is estimated to be 16-27 times higher in people infected with HIV than among those without HIV. The progress of HIV infection is accelerated by the presence of TB bacteria.

In this work, we put forth a novel HIV-TB coinfection model including the treatment and detection of both these diseases. We have also incorporated the presence of multi-drug resistant strains of TB (MDR-TB). All the different types of infections arising due to HIV have been clubbed into a single class in order to get a better understanding of the HIV-TB coinfection dynamics.

RESULTS

An important feature of a biological model is the Basic Reproduction Number. This helps in predicting the evolution of the disease with time.

The Reproduction Number for the TB sub-model is

The Reproduction Number for HIV-TB model is $R = \max\{R_1, R_2\}$




Figure 2: Concentration of cells for the full model by varying λ_H and λ_T




Figure 1: Change in value of the Basic Reproduction Number for the full model




Figure 3: Concentration of cells for the full model by varying λ_H and λ_T

CONCLUSION

- The model has been discussed in three parts the TB sub-model, the HIV sub-model, and the full model. We observed that the disease free equilibrium point and the endemic equilibrium point exist for the TB and HIV/AIDS submodels, and for the full model.
- Co-infected population is less than the population of TB, HIV/AIDS infected individuals, separately at the endemic equilibrium point for full model.
- For the TB sub-model, R₁ first decreased and then became constant when plotted against γ₁, γ₂, and σ₁ whereas it increased and then

- becomes constant when plotted against k_1 .
- In case of the HIV sub-model, R₂ first decreased and then became constant when plotted against η₂, μ, μ_H, and δ₁ but it increased and then became constant when plotted against θ.
- For the full model, the concentration of cells was plotted first, by keeping the force of infection associated with HIV/AIDS constant, and then by keeping the force of infection associated with TB constant, and we could see a noticeable change in case of the HIV/AIDS class and MDR TB-HIV/AIDS co-infection class.

FUTURE RESEARCH

In future we would like to extend the work to incorporating multiple drug regimes in the model. We would also like to study the impact of information on the spread of the HIV-TB co-infection in the population.

Abstract

The number of nodes typically used in sensory networks is growing rapidly, leading to large amounts of redundant data being exchanged between sensory terminals and computing units. To efficiently process such large amounts of data, and decrease power consumption, it is necessary to develop approaches to computing that operate close to or inside sensory networks, and that can reduce the redundant data movement between sensing and processing units. Here we examine the concept of near-sensor and in-sensor computing, in which computation tasks are moved partly to the sensory terminals. We classify functions into low-level and high-level processing, and discuss the implementation of near-sensor and in-sensor computing for different physical sensing systems. We also provide examples for near-/in-sensor computing for neuromorphic machine vision.

Brief Bio

Dr. Yang Chai is an Associate Professor in Department of Applied Physics, Vice President of Physical Society of Hong Kong, a member of The Hong Kong Young Academy of Sciences, the IEEE Distinguished Lecturer since 2016, and was the Chair of IEEE ED/SSC Hong Kong Chapter (2017-2019). He is a recipient of RGC Early Career Award in 2014, the Semiconductor Science and Technology Early Career Research Award in 2017, PolyU FAST Faculty Award in Research and Scholar Activities in 2018/2019, Young Scientist Award of ICON-2DMAT in 2019, PolyU President's Award in Research and Scholar Activities in 2019/2020, NR45 Young Innovators Award in 2021, and Young Scientist of World Laurate Association. His current research interest mainly focuses on emerging electronic devices.

Abstract

While silicon scaling has reached astonishing levels over the last half century, there has not been a corresponding level of scaling in electronic packaging technology. However, Artificial Intelligence (AI) architectures are now changing the landscape, increasingly moving us towards advanced packaging technology, especially Heterogeneous Integration (HI). What are these unique requirements of AI which are driving the need for HI? What are some of the unique challenges in semiconductor and packaging technologies that must be overcome to make this successful?

This seminar will discuss these questions, and touch upon the various integration methods and their characteristics. We will also review Through Silicon Via (TSV) technology and 3D integration, which are key elements on the road to achieving HI for AI architectures.

Biographical Sketch

Dr. Mukta Farooq is a Distinguished Research Staff Member at IBM Research. She is an IEEE Fellow, an IEEE EDS Distinguished Lecturer, and a Distinguished Alumna of IIT-Bombay (India). Mukta is a materials scientist with expertise in Heterogeneous and 3D Integration, CMOS BEOL, and Chip Package Interaction. Mukta received the IBM Outstanding Technical Achievement Award for the semiconductor industry's first high volume 3D logic wafer. Mukta has 223 granted US patents and numerous publications.
