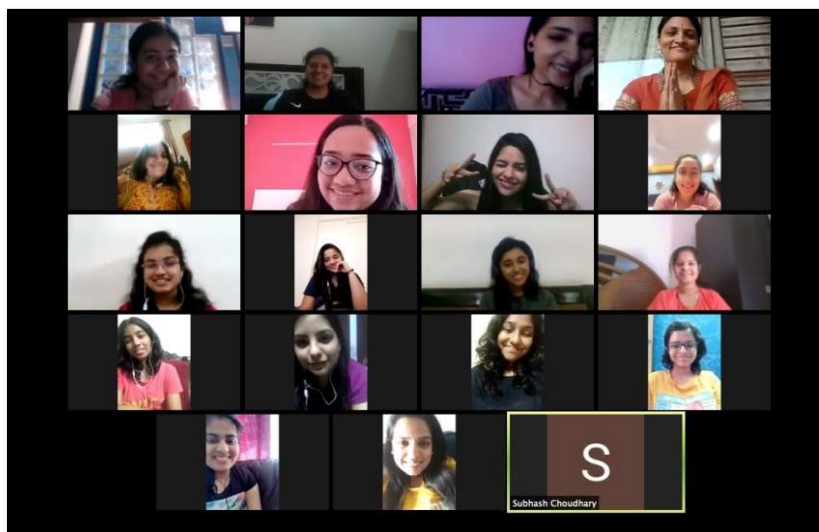
The interaction took place for various batches on different days which were as follows.

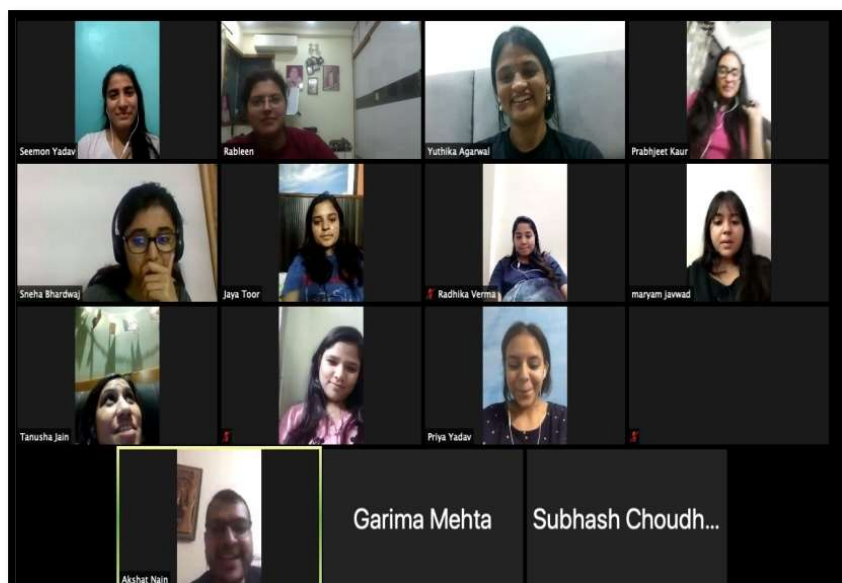
FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS

Feedback was also taken from the students for the sessions to know how the students really felt about the sessions and what could be better. The following feedback was received from the students:

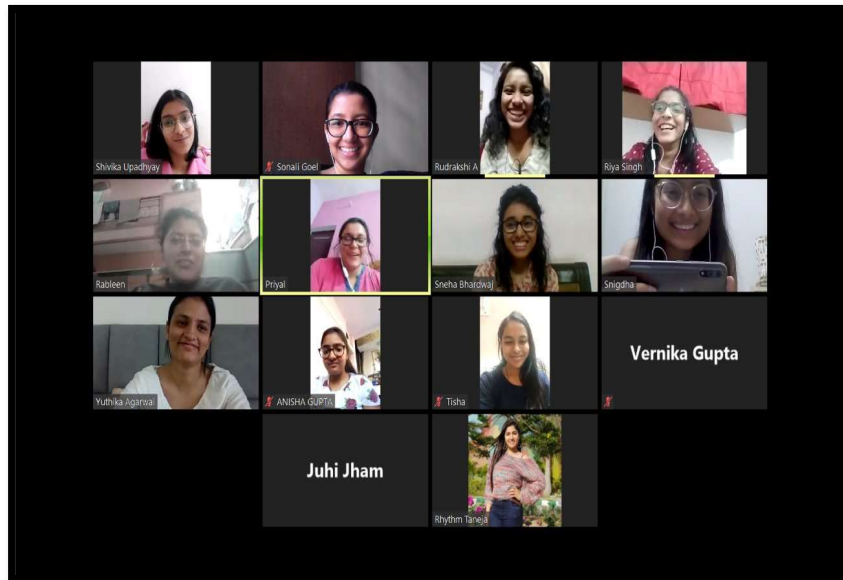

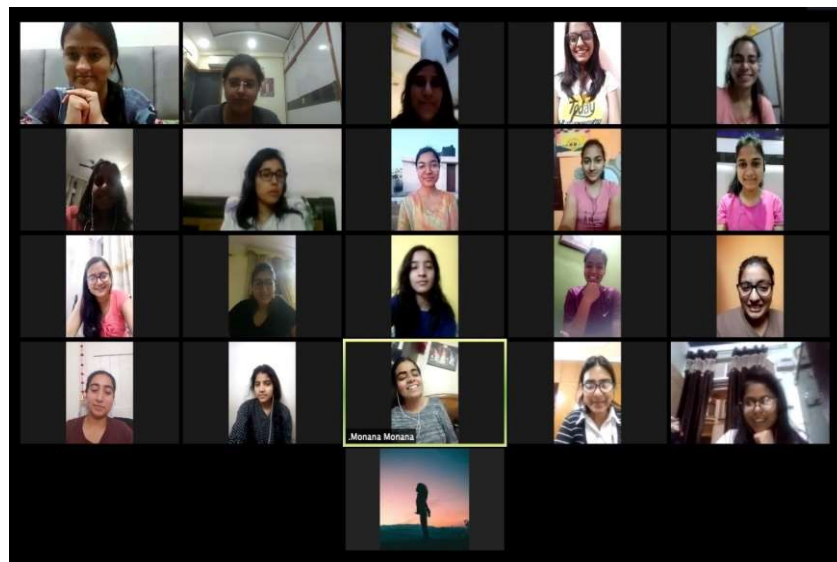
BMS 3rd Year: It was a good session, however screen sharing could have made it more engaging and the session fell flat at times.



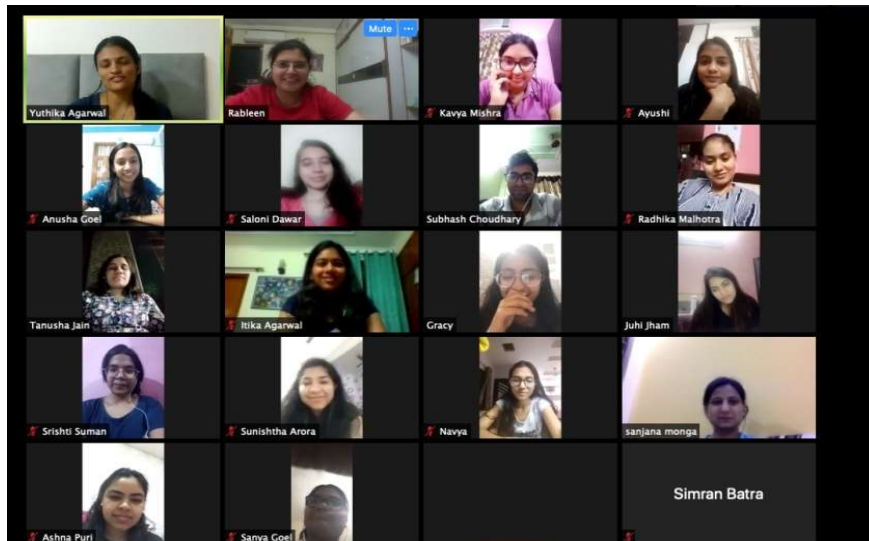

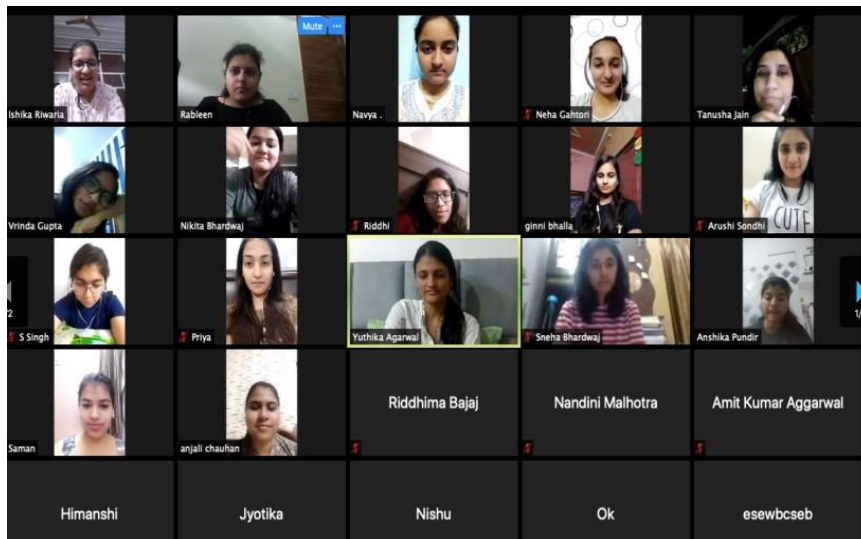
