Selection Criteria:

Interested candidates fulfilling essential qualification should apply by email at recruitment.nt@rajguru.du.ac.in along with Certificates in support of qualifications and experience. The last date of receiving application is 30-9-2024.

All the candidates who apply till last date of receipt of applications shall be called for **written test** details of which shall be placed on website only. The candidates are requested to refer to website for any update. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates. Appointment shall be subject to approval of competent authority.

- Candidates are advised to visit the website regularly regarding examination details and any other updates. No personal communication in this regard will be sent.
- The Candidates must ensure their eligibility regarding age, qualification, category before applying for the post. The candidates are allowed to appear in exam without any scrutiny of eligibility criteria, category, experience etc. Age relaxation shall be as per Govt. of India/DU rules. Final verification regarding eligibility will be ensured by the College at the time of appointment. candidature will be cancelled if found any discrepancy at any stage.

Detailed Syllabus:

(i) Questions pertaining to specific area of the post concerned: The questions will pertain to the specific area/skill of the post concerned..

(ii) General Awareness: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's General Awareness of the environment and its relevance to the society. The questions will also be designed to test knowledge of the current events and of such matters of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The test will include questions relating to India and her neighboring countries, especially pertaining to History, Indian Polity & Constitution, Art & Culture, Geography, Economics, General Policy, Science & Scientific Research, National/International Organizations /Institutions, events etc.

(iii) Reasoning Ability: The syllabus of General Intelligence includes questions of

both verbal and non- verbal types. Test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship, concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc.

(iv) Mathematical Ability: The test of Arithmetical and Numerical Ability will cover Number System including questions on Simplification, Decimals, Fractions, L.C.M., H.C.F., Ratio & Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit & Loss, Discount, Simple & Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Tables & Graphs, etc.

(v) Test of English/Hindi:

In addition to the testing of candidate's understanding of the English or Hindi Languages, its Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc. would also be tested.

Note:

1. The questions in the written test will be of the level of degree/diploma/examination which is defined as the minimum eligibility for the respective post.
2. The minimum overall qualifying marks for Paper I shall be 45% for the unreserved posts and 40% for the posts reserved for OBC category and 35% for the posts reserved for SC/ST/ PwBD category.
3. There shall be negative marking for wrong answers in Paper I to the tune of $1/4^{\text{th}}$ of marks allocated per question.

In case of bunching/bracketing of candidates in the results of the written test, the priority/merit list would be decided as follows:

- a) The candidate having more marks in aggregate in the examination/degree/diploma which is defined as the minimum eligibility for the respective post will be given preference.
- b) In case of further bunching/bracketing of candidates, candidate senior in age will be given preference.
- c) In case option at (a) and (b) is exhausted, it will be decided through draw of lots.
