2. In the same year, Dr. Anna and Dr. Kamil visited our institution in India, fostering cultural and scholarly exchange.
3. Continuing this enriching partnership, in 2019, the college hosted Dr. Jarka from the Robotics Lab, Opava, for academic interaction and collaborative discussions.
4. Also in 2019, Ms. Preeti and Ms. Venika from the Department of Electronics visited Silesian University in Opava as part of the academic exchange programme.
5. Adding another milestone to this growing international association, in 2025, three students from the Department of Computer Science represented our institution at Silesian University through the Erasmus+ Student Mobility Programme.
6. In 2026, with the visit of Dr. Kamil Matuła, the institution proudly marked its 11th in-person exchange under the Erasmus+ Programme.

Principal Prof. Payal Mago delivered the welcome address and shared her experiences related to the Erasmus+ Exchange Programme. She highlighted how the programme has significantly contributed to global friendship, cultural understanding, academic excellence, and international cooperation.



Dr. Kamil Matuła also shared his valuable insights on potential areas and possibilities for future collaborations between the institutions.
